BEHAVIOUR AT LKPS

At Lower Kersal Community Primary School, we believe that every child has a right to an education and that every teacher has a right to teach. It therefore imperative that we all have high expectations of children's behaviour and that we are consistent in the way we manage children's



behaviour. We expect the children to respect each other, adults, property and display good manners. Whilst we have pride in the behaviour of the majority of our pupils we do have a minority whose behaviour does not always meet with our expected standard. It is therefore vital that we recognise these behaviours and develop strategies for dealing with them. Whilst occasional reprimand is required from time to time our behaviour policy focuses on praise and the fostering of good relationships. Please ask your child about their behaviour at school and encourage them to follow the school rules – they are there to make everyone's time at LKPS as positive and educational as possible.

NAMES IN CLOTHES AND COATS

Please ensure that you put your child's name in to their uniform and coat. This makes it much easier to find if they get lost. School cannot be held responsible for lost items of clothing. Thank you.
